PRESENT AREA OF WORK & CONTRIBUTIONS:

RELIEF FOUNDATION:

- Founder and Chairperson of Relief Foundation, an Organization which was set up to find Rehabilitation Solutions for children in distress and in Institutional Care. Since Sep. 1998.
- Relief Foundation has done intense work with children in need of care and support especially in the Juvenile and Observation Homes in Chennai.
- Years of research revealed the cause of juvenile delinquency, and since 2008, all efforts are
 engaged in strengthening rural preprimary and primary education for children as a mode of
 prevention of delinquency and drop outs. Website: www.relieffoundation.in
- Currently Relief Foundation runs workshops for youth and adolescents on life skills and offers seed money and training for socio educational entrepreneurship projects. Teaching Fellowships are offered to youth to take up Montessori courses and qualify themselves to become Centre heads in the villages.
- Setting up an Erd Kinder program in Narasingapuram village where our city based and rural children can come together, learn and teach each other skills, along with local community resource persons.
- Lead a transformation team to build a residential tribal school in Wayanad, under the leadership of local youth, with funding from CARE Education, UK, providing indigenous good quality education for over 200 children.
- Relief Foundation has started Four Montessori Rural Resource centres, for children with the help of local parent groups and youth, training them in Montessori way of learning and practice, in the following villages:
 - o Jamunamarathur village off Thiruvannamalai (June 2015)
 - o Narasingapuram in Thiruvallur Districts (June 2015)
 - o Baripada in Mayurbhanj, Odisha (Jan 2021)



o Thettu (village), in rural Madanapalle, Andhra Pradesh (Aug 2021)

NETWORKING:

- Created a Whatsapp Group of Montessorians across the world, supporting them with classroom management information, besides parent study circle ideas, presentations.
- Parental awareness programs for parents of children 0 to 4 years, on Montessori way of parenting. Over 235 participants and 55 school teachers participated in this year's online sessions.
- Funded AMI Training for 10 trainees through Corporate Foundations.

CHILD RIGHTS:

- Community building besides spreading good parenting practices is the primary work of these centres. Children below 6 years come in to work in the Montessori preprimary classrooms and older children come in for reinforcement classes in the evenings. Parents come in for study circles and discussion forums, regularly. Outreach programs are offered to adjoining villages on parenting, women empowerment, authentic education and good parenting practices. Ensuring awareness and entitlement of Children's rights in the communities where we serve, the families have risen in stature by prioritizing education and respect for children. https://bit.ly/3z29mRn
- Relief Foundation under Vidya Shankar's leadership and guidance, has developed a path breaking tool to measure the Child Rights Compliance Index in schools. The tool has obtained copyrights and is launched to help schools certify themselves with an index that would grade them on entitlement of rights in their school. This tool will educate parents on the safety and wellbeing of their child if admitted into the school with higher order of compliance.
- Developed a rating tool for Preschools based on Child Rights and Development, and distributed it free to over 700 parents across India, seeking admissions into local schools, so that they are empowered to ask the right questions and rate it before deciding to admit their child.

Founded the **SuDatta Adoptive families associations** of Tamil Nadu and Karnataka. As an Adoption and Parenting Educator and was instrumental in creating a network of adoptive parents and adoption Interested persons throughout the country, offering counseling and support programs for parents and children to improve and better familial relationships since March 1995.

 A Family Counsellor by experience, with a passion to strengthen the society from within the family units assisting Children, Youth and Parents on the nuances of Building and Nurturing Relationships, offers parenting programs called "Nurturing Empowered Children"

JUVENILE JUSTICE

- Former Chairperson of Juvenile Welfare Board, Chennai District, from Aug 2001 to Dec 2003 and an adjudicating Member of Juvenile Justice Board (Juvenile Court) in Chennai from November 02 to Nov 05 adjudicating for rehabilitation of children.
- Has trained over 3000 teachers and Juvenile Justice Professionals on Child Rights and Child psychology besides laws related to children.
- Created public surveys on Child Rights Awareness, and Impact of increased screen time among young children, for parents, offering webinars to over 1000 young parents to empower them with information on conscious parenting practices.
- As a Former Trustee and Honorary CEO of Shriram Foundation the CSR Arm of the Shriram Group of companies, anchoring programs that covered over 9000 children every year in Government Juvenile Homes, and Schools.
- Continued resource support to Child Rights & Juvenile Justice Professionals, Police Department, National Judicial Academy and Judicial Officers on Laws related and interpreted for children.

OTHER SIGNIFICANT CONTRIBUTIONS:

- During Juvenile Justice tenure, conceived and implemented the Co Management concept of Government Children's Homes and Observation homes between 2000 to 2007, in the city of Chennai, with the Dept of Social Defence, Govt of Tamilnadu, serving children entering the Juvenile Justice system aided exclusively by public participation and contributions. This System of upgrading services to children with active civic participation with corporates and volunteers as seen as one of the first in the country to this extent in the area of family empowerment and child welfare. With a Rotary International's Matching Grant program, the Juvenile Homes were revamped with Steel kitchens and playground equipment besides vocational training machinery, in 2006/7. The campus lit up with these state of art improvement, much to the comfort of the inmates, and was hailed by all in the department, including the several visitors and the IAS officers.
- Was the Chairperson of a Committee to Review the implementation of the Juvenile Justice Act by the Juvenile Justice Boards across the country, set up by the National Commission for

- Protection of Child Rights (NCPCR) in 2007 and completed the Report on the functioning of the Juvenile Justice Boards in select states in the country.
- Presented a session on "Building Montessori Families" in the Fifth Assembly of Education sans Frontiers an International Conference on Montessori practices around the world, in Aug 2016.
- Conducted a series of training sessions for Administrators and Caregivers of SOS Children's village, Tambaram Chennai on developmental needs, effect of media, preventive teaching and positive communication for primary age children.
- Functions as a resource person for Law makers and Education functionaries of the Government to have ready reference of the laws related to children, as well as updation of their knowledge related to justice delivery systems.

CASCADE FAMILY LEARNING SERVICES – A NEW MODEL IN EDUCATION

Conceived and developed a new parent led Montessori educational resource centre model in the city, for families fostering parent involvement and co-operative learning in educating children. www.cascadefls.org that is now a fully autonomous educational eco-system run by Montessori trained parents in 4 centres, in the city of Chennai, offering Montessori programs across ages from toddler to adolescents. CASCADE FLS distributed free vacation advisories to families of children 2.5 to 11 years of age, to follow through during Covid Times. Many of the families across the country are in touch, looking for Montessori schooling near their locations. It is noteworthy to mention that CASCADE FLS was / is open through the Covid times, and functioning to full strength, thanks to the cooperative of families who follow the Covid safety practices completely in order to provide for children, the concrete experience, while safeguarding their interest in good health. We follow a good diet and physical fitness protocols at all times, which enabled the families to easily accept the norms and follow through.
